

## **PROGRAM OVERVIEW:**

The Department of Defense (DoD) Voluntary Education (VolEd) Program, through the Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support (DANTES), offers on-line, self-paced, academic skills training courses to help military members gain the knowledge they need to complete education credentials and college degree programs, advance in their military careers, and successfully transition into the civilian workforce.

#### Online Academic Skills Course (OASC)

The OASC course provides easy-to-use instruction to help service members build foundational academic skills in math, English, and science. It can be used as a stand-alone course or as a supplement to other educational resources. Service education counselors can also register for an educator account to track a student's progress and provide further guidance.

- Exams, quizzes, and full-length practice assessments to test knowledge
- Lessons/videos to focus on skills needed and skip content you already know
- Self-paced and flexible learning 24/7
- Mobile app with off-line study material (OASC Academic Skills Training)
