

CLEP Exams with Remote Proctoring Now Available



The College-Level Examination Program® (CLEP®) now offers test takers the option to take a CLEP exam with remote proctoring.

About Remote Proctoring

Remote proctoring allows students to take CLEP exams online while a human proctor monitors them via video.

To support students taking remote-proctored CLEP exams, CLEP is working with Proctortrack, a secure online remote proctoring solution that verifies the identity of online test takers.

About CLEP Exams with Remote Proctoring

All 34 CLEP exams can be taken with remote proctoring. Each remote-proctored exam has the same timing, content, format, and on-screen experience as the test you would take at a CLEP test center.

Remote Proctoring Requirements

If you don't meet the following requirements, you won't be able to take a remote-proctored CLEP exam. For a detailed list of requirements, visit clep.collegeboard.org/clep-exams-remote-proctoring/clep-remote-proctoring-requirements.

Test-Taker Eligibility

- Must be at least 13 years old.
- Must be located in the U.S. OR be DANTEs-funded.

Equipment Requirements

- Must test on a computer (PC only, no Macs or Chromebooks)
- Must have:
 - ♦ webcam
 - ♦ speaker
 - ♦ microphone
- Taking notes on regular paper is not allowed, for security purposes.
- Must use:
 - ♦ a dry erase marker on a whiteboard
 - ♦ a dry erase marker and one transparent sheet protector.

Technical Requirements

Proctortrack will do a system check of test takers' computers during the scheduled exam appointment. Visit the Proctortrack website for a full list of technical requirements (testing.verificient.com/clep/#!/welcome).

Environment and Testing Space

- Test taker must be in a room alone.
- Outdoor and public spaces aren't allowed.
- Computer must be on a desk or table.
- Test taker must sit in a standard chair.
- Testing area must be clear of all items not approved for use during the test.

How to Sign Up

- 1 Select Your Exam.** Go to clep.collegeboard.org/register. Select the exam you'd like to take.
- 2 Sign In.** Log in to the CLEP My Account Registration Portal to complete your exam registration.
- 3 Select Your Preferred Test Center.** When you reach the Preferred Test Center section, you'll be asked where you'd like to test. Click **Via remote proctoring**.
Note: If you require accommodations for your exam and haven't been approved by College Board yet, you won't be able to complete registration.
- 4 Register and Check Out.** To complete registration, make sure all your information is correct, including your personal information, military service information (if applicable), and score send information.
Note: You'll be charged a \$30 remote proctoring fee along with your exam fee. If you're DANTES-funded, your exam fee and remote proctoring fee will display as \$0.00.
- 5 Schedule Your Exam with Proctortrack.** You'll receive a confirmation email from CLEP with your ticket ID, a link to the Proctortrack website, and instructions for creating your Proctortrack account and scheduling your exam.
